Skills we already should know

- Know some places that are not real i.e. fantasy worlds.
- Know that there are places outside of planet Earth sun, moon etc
- Know some events that happened in the past in our own lives.

What skills we're going to develop

- Talk about past and present events in their own lives and in the lives of family members.
- Explore fiction and non-fiction text types creating our own stories and fact books based on our ideas and knowledge.
- Answer questions about basic past and present events, aiming to transfer to drawing or writing work.
- Recognise the difference between past and present events in their own lives and others.
- Find answers to simple questions about the past from sources of information e.g. artefacts.
- Discuss changes over time of landscapes based on seasons growing and planting.


